The charge given to participants at last weekend's Millions More Movement rally and march in Washington, D.C. was to start building a movement.

Milwaukee Ald. Mike McGee, Jr., who led a group of 40 high school and middle school students to the event, wants to build on the momentum provided by that event at a town hall meeting tonight, Friday, October 21, 2005.

The town hall meeting will feature Professor Griff of the activist rap group Public Enemy. It will be held at the African American Women's Center, 3020 W. Vliet St. Doors open at 6:00 p.m. Media Coverage is welcome.

"I want to capitalize on the emotion and inspirational messages we received at the march to continue working for change in Milwaukee," said Ald. McGee. "The Millions More Movement asks all of us to reach across racial and ethnic boundaries and work to build a social and economic movement that will lift the poor out of poverty, and I believe we can make an impact on our local community."

Milwaukee high school and middle school students joined hundreds of people from Milwaukee and Wisconsin and thousands from throughout the country on October 15th on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. in commemoration of the 10th anniversary of the Million Man March.
