
Heavy Lift Dock (220 MT Crane)



Terminal 2 – Federal Marine Terminals




Current 18 Acres (7.29 Hectors) of Outside Storage




Direct Highway Access for High/Wide Loads from the Port of Milwaukee Now Completed

- Over-dimensional (o/d) truck loads now have convenient, direct Interstate Highway on-ramp access from all port docks. The rebuilt on-ramp to I-794 has a 200' (61 meter) radius to allow access for trucks even with extra-long trailers.
- Oversize loads, such as wind blades and project cargoes, are now able to enter the highway quickly and eliminate the need for city o/d permits!
- Efficient, quick, safe, direct.
