Chapter 5: Use of Force and Deadly Force Practices

How many findings did you cover: 9

Finding #16 and Recommendations:

We recommend that training on how and what to collect be implemented for IAD to improve their conduct around use of force investigations.

Finding #17 and Recommendations:

We recommend discussing with the community with the most useful type of evidence; creating a guideline that allows citywide investigative policies.

Finding #19 & 20 and Recommendations:

We recommend that video be used consistently regardless of type of case.

We recommend that officer's report any time there is citizen contact.

We recommend the review of best practices nation-wide, create one for Milwaukee, and give clear policy/practice to community for understanding around how documentation be collected and disseminated.

Finding #25 and Recommendations:

We recommend that audio and video recording of civilian and officer witnesses be required.

Finding #26 and Recommendations:

We recommend that BWCs be activated and deactivated by a third party.

We recommend the BWCs be reviewed by a third party.

We recommend that BWCs be on as a standard operating procedure of the MPD when officers are on duty.

Finding #27 and Recommendations:

We recommend that officer's personnel records concerning complaints and incidents around use of force be public record.

We recommend a flagging system that makes a pattern of behavior clear for any police officer, which would be public record.

Finding #30 and Recommendations:

We recommend that the FPC reports quarterly both the discharge and drawing of officer weapons.

Finding #32 and Recommendations:

We recommend that the community be informed promptly around use of force incidents; this should take no longer than two weeks.
