## Residence Preference Program (RPP)

### Are you a City of Milwaukee resident looking for work?

The City of Milwaukee's Residents Preference Program (RPP) connects local eligible residents like you to jobs on City-funded and certain private development projects. This program ensures that public investment creates opportunities for the people who live here, helping you and our community thrive.

### Who Qualifies

- 1** **Verify Unemployment Status By:**
  - Working less than 1,200 hours in past year
  - Being unemployed for the last 15 days
- OR Verify Underemployment Status By:**
  - Income Guidelines (View RPP Affidavit online)

### What to Bring

- 2** **Eligible Proof of City of Milwaukee Residency**
  - Valid government-issued photo ID
  - Utility bill, lease, or official mail
  - Resume not required, but recommended for construction or landscaping experience

### Next Steps

- 3**
  - Participants will sign and date Affidavit
  - Affidavits will be notarized and submitted for certification review
  - Certification does not guarantee employment
