

The Linnwood Water Treatment Plant

The Linnwood Water Treatment Plant has Neo Gothic architecture with a tiled roof and a Lannon stone exterior. Vermont marble was used for the flooring. Mankato stone panels the walls. There are alternating carvings of a well and waterfall in the panels above the windows and doors. The filter building has quarry tile on the floors and terra cotta paneling the walls. A skylight above each filter provides natural lighting.
