Lake Michigan is our source of drinking water. We pump it in from intakes 1-1/4 and 2-1/4 miles from shore and 60 feet down.

THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN DETERMINES OUR WATER RATES AND SERVICE CHARGES

Service Reliability: We replace water mains using an index that ranks the condition of each main segment and its chances of failure

As stewards of public health, we are regulated by the Environmental Protection Agency and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources

OUR 9-STEP treatment process

uses biologically active filtration and ozone disinfection to destroy contaminants and microorganisms, and remove lake taste and odor
