Ald. Joe Davis Appointed To League Of Wisconsin Municipalities' Committee

Milwaukee Common Council member Joe Davis, Sr., has been appointed to the Resolutions Committee for the League of Wisconsin Municipalities' annual conference. The group will meet October 14 and 15, 2009 in Appleton, WI and this year's event is focused on engineering and public works.

The group is a voluntary nonprofit and nonpartisan association of cities and villages that acts as an information clearinghouse, lobbying organization and legal resource for Wisconsin municipalities. Ald. Davis, who just this year was appointed to the 40 member Board of Directors of the National League of Cities (NLC), has a great deal of experience in sharing Milwaukee's needs and innovations with other city and municipality groups.

"I'm always proud to take our experiences to the NLC and the League of Wisconsin Municipalities. It is essential for us to stay in dialog with other municipalities on the state and national level so that we can share ideas and successes," Ald. Davis said.

Ald. Davis, who is the chair of the Common Council's Community and Economic Development Committee, has served in multiple positions with the National League of Cities and was one of only 12 members selected to oversee the national organization's financial direction.
