Volunteers to Join Alderman Davis in Cleanup of Elderly Couple's Flood Damaged Basement

Couple – both in their 80s -- need help and Alderman Davis and Teen Challenge members will roll up their sleeves at 1 p.m. on Monday

Ald. Joe Davis, Sr. will be joined by members of **Teen Challenge** during a volunteer cleanup of the basement of **Clarence and Margaret Zuba** at 1 p.m. on Monday (October 25, 2010). The couple's residence at 4174 N. 62nd St., sustained flood damage caused by the July storms that dumped record rainfall amounts in Milwaukee.

Alderman Davis said Teen Challenge began as a Christian organization that believes strongly in community service and "giving back" to help others. He said the organization now mentors men and women who are trying to put their lives back together, and some of those adults will be joining him at the Zuba home on Monday. "These adults are looking to help themselves by setting a positive example for others to aim for," he said.

"These volunteers will be doing some fairly dirty and difficult work, giving their time to help an elderly couple in need, and showing everyone that they're willing to step in and do positive things in the community," Alderman Davis said. "These people are a true asset to the 2nd Aldermanic District and to the City of Milwaukee."
