Public Invited to Emergency Flood Disaster Meeting

Local and federal officials will discuss possible relief options at Monday's public meeting at Marshall High School

Ald. Joe Davis, Sr. will host a public meeting on **Monday, September 20, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. at Marshall High School** that will focus on the damaging flood events of July 16 and July 22, and possible options of relief for city property owners.

Officials from the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD), the city Department of Public Works, and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will be at the meeting to answer questions and discuss the July flood events that caused tens of millions of dollars in damage to homes and properties, and to public infrastructure in Milwaukee.

Alderman Davis, chair of the Common Council's Community and Economic Development Committee, said residents deserve the chance to ask questions and discuss issues related to the disastrous flooding that occurred. "The public has a right to question government officials about how and why certain things happened, and also to find out more about possible options of relief," he said.
