Alderman Donovan to take Part in Clean Up News Conference TODAY

Alderman Bob Donovan will participate in a 10:30 a.m. news conference **TODAY** (Wednesday, September 21) regarding a large neighborhood clean up on the near south side. The cleanup – scheduled to take place from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. – is being coordinated by the **Milwaukee Christian Center**.

Free hot dogs and refreshments for volunteers will be served from noon to 1 p.m. at the clean up's main staging area at S. 23rd and W. Lapham Streets.

Alderman Donovan said volunteers will pick up litter in the area bounded by S. 21st St. on the east, S. Layton Blvd. (S. 27th St.) on the west, W. Lapham St. on the north and W. Forest Home Ave. on the south. "This is a very densely populated area that can use some assistance in tidying things up a bit, and we're very fortunate to have the help of some willing partners and selfless volunteers," he said.
