City Hall Ceremony to Celebrate Doors Open Milwaukee

Mayor Tom Barrett will be joined by **Alderman Robert J. Bauman** and **Alderman Nik Kovac** of the Milwaukee Common Council in presenting citations to officials from **Historic Milwaukee, Inc.** during a special ceremony tomorrow marking the start of the inaugural two-day **Doors Open Milwaukee** event (**Saturday, September 24 and Sunday, September 25, from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.**).

The ceremony will take place tomorrow (**Saturday, September 24**) at 9:00 a.m. in the first floor Rotunda at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.

For the first time ever, the Doors Open Milwaukee event offers an opportunity to see the inner workings of notable buildings and locations in downtown and throughout the metro area. **Free and open to the public**, participants can choose to go through the buildings on self-guided tours or take one of the many in-depth tours given by expert guides.

At City Hall, the first three floors will be open to the public, and guided tours of the bell tower and the Common Council Chamber will also be offered (**NOTE:** spots will be limited on the bell tower tours, and participants will be required to sign a waiver beforehand).
