## **Milwaukee Police Continue to Succeed**

**February 22, 2012**

Less than one month ago, we praised the partnership of police and neighbors in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Aldermanic District for their great police work and helpful information to secure the arrest of a man believed to be responsible for a string of garage burglaries that have plagued the area.

Today, we can again be thankful for solid police work because two men, Jason Wilson and Robert Nash, were apprehended for their involvement in a series of robberies, including theft from numerous auto parts store locations in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Aldermanic District.

Police were investigating the two men and witnessed them in action on February 14. After police followed the men to a residence, the men were apprehended and a search warrant yielded recovery of the money obtained in the robbery, two semi-automatic pistols, a rifle and bullet-resistant body armor.

The two men have each been arrested for more than 27 felony charges resulting from their crimes and to the credit of Milwaukee Police Department's skill, none of the victims, suspects or police officers was injured in the operation.

The joint operation was planned and supervised by Lt. Steven Gabrish of the Central Investigations Division. District 3 Police Officers Patrick Fuhrman, Richard Litwin and Steven Strasser, and Detectives Vanessa Harms, Harold Young, Herb Glidewell and Britt Kohnert were instrumental in this successful mission. Assistant District Attorney Jacob Corr brought the charges in the case and continues to review subsequent cases in these robberies.

I must continue to offer highest praises for the professional work of District 7 Police, the Milwaukee Police Department overall and the continued efforts to thwart crime in our area. Thank you, MPD, for getting the job done.
