### Alderman Bohl news conference Thursday on fluoridation legislation

**Alderman Jim Bohl** will hold a news conference at City Hall tomorrow (**Thursday, May 31**) to address his resolution that seeks to end the fluoridation of Milwaukee's drinking water – as well as a companion resolution that would create a grant program to provide dental care services to those in Milwaukee who have either no access to dental care or simply cannot afford it.

Fluoridation experts **Paul Connett, Yolanda Whyte, and Bill Osmunson** will join Alderman Bohl during the news conference.

**The news conference will begin at 11 a.m. in the first floor rotunda at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.**

The legislation is scheduled to be heard by the Common Council's **Steering and Rules Committee** during its meeting tomorrow at 1:30 p.m. in room 301-B at City Hall.
