Common Council members will call for U.S. Attorney investigation into Derek Williams death

Members of the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a news conference at City Hall this afternoon (**Monday, September 24**) to call on the U.S. Attorney's office to launch an investigation into the death last year of Derek Williams while in Milwaukee Police Custody. These council members feel that recently released dash cam video raises questions about how police handled Derek Williams while he was struggling to breathe, and that a U.S. Attorney's investigation will provide more accountability and greater transparency in this case.

The news conference will begin at 3:00 p.m. in the first floor rotunda at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.
