Police Chief and Sheriff to appear Wednesday at Public Safety Committee

Milwaukee Police Chief Edward Flynn and **Milwaukee County Sheriff David Clarke** are set to appear at tomorrow's meeting of the Common Council's Public Safety Committee. The committee will meet at 9 a.m. Wednesday (January 11) in room 301-B at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.

Alderman Bob Donovan, chair of the Public Safety Committee, said he invited Chief Flynn and Sheriff Clarke to discuss several key public safety topics affecting Milwaukee. "I am hopeful we can have a very frank and open discussion about resources and plans for keeping our parks, our lakefront, our buses, and our neighborhoods safe in 2012," he said.

Alderman Donovan said he is also planning to ask Sheriff Clarke about the impacts of recent layoffs of dozens of sheriff's deputies.
