## Nominations sought for 2013 Dr. James G. White 6<sup>th</sup> District Difference Makers Awards

She is now seeking nominations for the **2013 Dr. James G. White 6<sup>th</sup> District Difference Makers Award**. Dr. White was a resident of the 6<sup>th</sup> District who served as a county supervisor and the regional vice president of WestCare Wisconsin Harambee Community Center, facilitating countless neighborhood projects and programs and always using his gifts, talents and knowledge to improve and empower his community.

Four awards will be presented to 6<sup>th</sup> District residents, one to a community organization and one to a block club, all of which have contributed to making their neighborhood a better place.
