## Festival starts Friday on Historic Mitchell St.

The **2013 Sun Fair**, a free three-day festival along W. Historic Mitchell St. from S. 8th St. to S. 11th St., will run from Friday, May 31, through Sunday, June 2.

**Alderman José G. Pérez** will be joined by **Mayor Tom Barrett** to officially open the festival **at 5:30 p.m. tomorrow (Friday, May 31)** at the west end of the 1000 block of W. Historic Mitchell St.

The family-friendly event is sponsored by the Mitchell Street Business Improvement District (BID) No. 4 and the Historic Mitchell Street Preservation Corp., and will again feature an array of music, food and beverage vendors, dancing, vendors, rides, games, and a carnival. The festival will include the South Side Cultural Tent, which will include a display of historic photos, artifacts, and other historical items from the south side's earlier days.
