Alderman Hamilton, community leaders to announce Million Man March commemoration

Alderman Ashanti Hamilton, activists and other community leaders will gather Friday in the City Hall rotunda to announce a schedule of weekend events commemorating the Million Man March that happened 19 years ago.

The Million Man March took place on October 16, 1995 and was called by the Honorable Minister Louis Farrakhan. It attracted nearly 2 million black men and inspired a renewed commitment to uplifting the black community. Organizers of this local event intend to revive this message to address the condition of Black Milwaukee.

Alderman Hamilton and other local leaders will call on black men to march against violence on **Saturday, October 18**. The march will begin at 1:00 p.m. at the Wisconsin Black Historical Society, 2620 W. Center St., and will be followed by a panel discussion at 3:00 p.m.
