Alderman Davis to hold news conference to discuss Dontre Hamilton death investigation

Alderman Joe Davis, Sr. will hold a news conference at City Hall at **2:30 p.m. TODAY** to discuss the handling of the officer-involved shooting death of **Dontre Hamilton**. The news conference will be held in the third floor Council Chamber anteroom at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.

Alderman Davis, a member of the Common Council's Public Safety Committee, said he will be addressing serious concerns raised by a *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel* article (published yesterday, February 15) that calls into question whether the Hamilton case was handled correctly according to a new state law that requires a team of at least two investigators from an outside agency to lead investigations of officer-involved deaths.

Mr. Hamilton was shot to death by a Milwaukee police officer during an altercation on April 30, 2014 at Red Arrow Park.
