Alderman Davis: Saturday activity on streetcar petition drive

Alderman will take part in rally, petition circulating event

Alderman Joe Davis, Sr. will take part in a "Stop the trolley petition drive" session **from noon to 4 p.m. tomorrow (Saturday, January 17, 2015)** at the Elks Lodge (main hall), **5555 W. Good Hope Rd**. The alderman will take part in a rally urging residents to sign and circulate the petition seeking a binding referendum on the downtown streetcar project.
