### **Alderman Donovan to be part of Kenosha anti-streetcar event**

*Alderman will lend moral support for opponents of proposed expansion*

Alderman Bob Donovan will participate in a town hall event at 7 p.m. TONIGHT that will include former Kenosha Mayor John D. Bilotti and supporters of Common Sense Kenosha to rally support for opposing the city's planned streetcar route expansion. The event will take place at the Women's Club of Kenosha, 6028 8<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Alderman Donovan said the planned route expansion in Kenosha would cost approximately \$10 million, with federal funds paying \$8 million and the city picking up \$2 million of the cost. "This expansion makes no sense, and if it's built it won't have sufficient ridership to make ends meet or even have it be of any value to residents. Sounds familiar, doesn't it?!" he said.
