### **Public Safety Committee to hear update on inspection of key railroad bridge**

The **Public Safety Committee** meeting tomorrow (**Thursday, July 9**) will include a report from the city engineer relative to the inspection conducted on the aging railroad bridge at S. 1<sup>st</sup> St. and Oregon. On April 29, 2015, Public Safety Committee Chair **Alderman Terry L. Witkowski** and **Alderman Robert J. Bauman** introduced Common Council legislation urging state and federal regulators to conduct immediate and thorough inspections of the railroad tracks, crossings and bridges on which highly combustible Bakken crude oil is carried through Milwaukee. Thursday's meeting will provide an update on the first round of those inspections.

Tomorrow's meeting will take place at **9 a.m.** at **City Hall, Room 301-B, located at 200 E. Wells St.** The meeting will be televised live on the City Channel (Channel 25 on Time Warner Cable and on AT&T U-Verse Channel 99) in the City of Milwaukee.
