Ald. Johnson: Huge early voting turnout happening at Midtown Center

To date, more than 4,000 people have taken advantage of the in-person absentee voting location at Midtown Center in the 2nd Aldermanic District, according to **Alderman Cavalier Johnson**.

“I cannot express how very pleased I am with the huge turnout (of in-person absentee voters) at the Midtown Center location (5700 W. Capitol Pkwy.),” Alderman Johnson said.

The move by the city to add additional sites for early voting is clearly paying off, Alderman Johnson said.

“The election on November 8 will determine the course of our country for the next four years and beyond, and it is vital that people have their voice heard,” he said. “The City of Milwaukee has worked diligently to increase the amount of time and options for voters to cast a ballot, and we are proud to see such a high turnout and expect thousands of voters to continue to turn out to vote prior to Election Day.”
