Mayor Tom Barrett, along with members of Milwaukee's Common Council, the Wisconsin Bike Fed, Bublr Bikes, and Department of Public Works (DPW) staff, will bike to work on Monday, June 6, 2016 to celebrate Wisconsin Bike Week. This year, there will be three (3) separate, concurrent rides from different areas of the city. **WHERE:** **Mayor's ride: Meet at W. Washington Boulevard at N. 51<sup>st</sup> St.**  
Washington Blvd. east through Washington Park to Highland Ave. - Highland to N. 26<sup>th</sup> St. – south on 26<sup>th</sup> St. to W. State St. – east on State St. to N. 6<sup>th</sup> St. – south on 6<sup>th</sup> St. to W. Kilbourn Ave. – east on Kilbourn to N. Market St.

**Ald. Kovac's ride: Meet at Gordon Park, 2828 N. Humboldt**  
Beerline Trail south to Commerce Street – Commerce St. to the ramp to the Marsupial Bridge – bridge to Water Street – south on Water St. to City Hall

**Ald. Perez's ride: Meet at Walker's Square Park, 1031 S. 9<sup>th</sup> St.**  
East on Washington St. to S. 2<sup>nd</sup> St.- north on 2<sup>nd</sup> /Plankinton Ave to Wells St. – east on Wells to City Hall
