### **Public Safety Committee to examine issues of prostitution and human trafficking**

The Milwaukee Common Council's Public Safety Committee will discuss the issues of prostitution and human trafficking, and the impact they have on the community, during its regular meeting at 9:00 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, September 29.
