Work underway at site of restaurant fire

Crews are removing debris and working to remediate the condition of the burned-out Burger King restaurant near N. 85th St. and W. Brown Deer Rd., according to **Alderwoman Chantia Lewis**.

“I am pleased to see crews working to remove debris and beginning the process of making the property usable once again,” Alderwoman Lewis said.

The restaurant caught fire on May 20, causing \$463,000 in damage to the restaurant building and \$218,000 in damage to the contents of the restaurant (fixtures, furniture, machinery, food, etc.). Authorities believe the fire started accidentally after someone discarded a cigarette that was still burning.

“I believe the site will be the Phoenix and will rise from the ashes to again be a viable location for a successful business,” she said.
