C-viche, specializing in Latin American small-plates, opening in Bay View

In another “big get” for the Kinnickinnic Avenue Business Improvement District, 14th District **Alderman Tony Zielinski** said that **C-viche**, a new restaurant and bar specializing in Latin American small-plates, plans to open its doors next week.

Co-owners Karlos Soriano and Paco Villar will officially open C-viche for business on **Thursday, January 21 at 11 a.m.** Featuring varying styles of ceviche as the establishment’s signature dishes, the restaurant will also offer other cuisine from countries including Peru, Argentina and Mexico, as well as a lunch menu.

“Only in Bay View can Milwaukeeans find such a diverse selection of multi-cultural food and drink options within such a self-contained, pedestrian-friendly environment,” Alderman Zielinski said. “I’m excited to welcome Karlos and Paco to the neighborhood, and eager to continue to build upon this area’s growing momentum.”

The new bar and restaurant will open at **2165 S. Kinnickinnic Ave.**, filling the vacancy left by Lovely Salon. With Villar as bar manager, C-viche will feature specialty drinks like pisco sour, Dominican-style sangria and other South American cocktails. The co-owners hope to open a back patio in the summer.

“We’ve poured a lot of ourselves and our heritage into launching C-viche,” Villar said, “but we couldn’t be more grateful to Alderman Zielinski for his role in helping shepherd this project through to completion. His input has been invaluable.”
