### **Committee agenda includes MPD policy on employee-involved domestic violence**

Representatives from the Milwaukee Police Department will appear before the **Public Safety Committee** at City Hall tomorrow (**Friday, April 7**) to discuss the MPD's internal policy on employee-involved domestic violence. The testimony will be taken as part of a communication file on the topic sponsored by **Alderman Milele A. Coggs**.

The file – co-sponsored by **Alderman Chantia Lewis** and **Alderman José G. Pérez** – is aimed at sparking discussion about the current policy and whether any updates or changes should be considered, Alderman Coggs said. “There was a very recent tragic (murder-suicide) domestic violence incident involving a police department employee that has brought this issue to the forefront of the minds of many,” she said.
