### **News conference at 2:00 p.m. Monday to address property targeted in city “bawdy house” lawsuit**

**Alderman Bob Donovan** and **Alderman José G. Pérez** will host a joint news conference at **2:00 p.m. on Monday, July 10** in front of Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church (S. 23<sup>rd</sup> St. and W. Greenfield Ave.) to discuss the City of Milwaukee lawsuit against the owners of a home described as a “hub of prostitution” on the city’s near south side.

The city’s “bawdy house” nuisance suit against owners **Richard Williams** and **Jacqueline Kiefer** seeks to abate the prostitution activity that is occurring from the property, located at **2412 W. Greenfield Ave.** City officials say prostitution-related activity has been ongoing at the property since at least 2012, and a Milwaukee Police Department investigation since the beginning of 2017 prompted by citizen complaints gathered enough evidence to support allegations in Circuit Court.

Joining Aldermen Donovan and Pérez for Monday’s news conference will be Assistant City Attorney **Heather Hecimovich Hough**.
