News conference to address mayoral veto on measure to enable Council to fire police chief

Alderman Tony Zielinski will host a **City Hall** news conference at **12 p.m. (noon) tomorrow** (Thursday, October 19) to address Mayor Barrett's veto of the Council resolution adopted yesterday relating to the removal of the chief of police from office. The Council voted 8 yes, 6 noes (and one member excused) in favor of the measure, which seeks a state law change to allow the Council to terminate a chief of police on a super-majority vote.

Joining Alderman Zielinski will be **Alderman Bob Donovan**, chair of the Public Safety and Health Committee, and **Alderman Mark A. Borkowski**, chair of the Judiciary and Legislation Committee, and **Alderman José G. Pérez**.
