The fall General Election is less than two months away! There is still time to request your absentee ballot by visiting myvote.wi.gov. You can request a ballot through Oct. 29th, register to vote and check the status of your ballot.

The Milwaukee Public Libraries are also available for voter assistance. Visit your local library to request an absentee ballot, register to vote, receive a witness signature or drop off your absentee ballot in a secure drop box. Restart Grants Allocated



Recently, the Department of City Development announced the recipients for the first round of restart grants.

These grants provide assistance for COVID-19 affected, established, small businesses throughout the city. Business could receive a max. of \$15k for PPE, replenishing perishable inventory and modifications to protect workers and patrons.
