170524	Resolution directing the Health Department to provide semi-annual reports to the Common Council regarding blood lead testing of children in the city, and regarding the policies and actions taken by the Health Department with respect to children found with elevated blood lead levels.
170463	Substitute resolution relating to the establishment of a Pioneering Innovations Commission to keep abreast of developments in academic research and a broad range of emerging strategies for dealing with societal issues.
170361	A substitute ordinance relating to roadside memorials.
170337	Substitute resolution expressing the City's support for the Paris Climate Accord.
170198	Resolution expressing the City of Milwaukee's support for a pilot program to place free menstrual products in University of Wisconsin-Madison campus buildings.
170173	Substitute resolution directing the Department of City Development to facilitate creation of a business cooperative providing basic goods and services to major Milwaukee employers and institutions.
170172	Resolution requesting the Wisconsin Secretary of Transportation to increase the frequency of highway litter abatement in counties containing cities of the 1st class.
170091	Substitute resolution relating to the City of Milwaukee's position on County, State and Federal legislation intended to reduce incarceration and violence.
161757	Substitute resolution expressing the City of Milwaukee's support for bi-partisan redistricting of state legislative boundaries as sought by the plaintiffs in William Whitford, et al. v. Beverly R. Gill, et al.
161756	Substitute resolution directing the Department of Administration - Intergovernmental Relations Division to oppose any attempt to reduce Community Development Block Grant and other funding provided to cities by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
