Garden Homes Neighborhood Plan One Year Update & Fellowship tonight

Common Council President Ashanti Hamilton invites residents to attend the one year anniversary update of the Garden Homes Neighborhood Action Plan. This event will take place on tonight (**Monday, December 3, 2018**), **5:30 PM at Milwaukee Collegiate Academy, located at 4030 N. 29th Street.**

The 2018 Garden Homes Neighborhood Plan was created during a process led by the 30th Street Industrial Corridor Corporation since 2016. Over 200 residents and 50 entities (churches, community based organizations, businesses, the Milwaukee Police Department, elected officials, etc.) engaged in a process to create a neighborhood plan that works to improve the neighborhood, and to increase coordination and collaboration amongst stakeholders.

The plan generated over 30 outcomes to be achieved, and focuses on seven areas: neighborhood pride, housing, education and intergenerational opportunities, health & wellness, economic development, employment and safety. Over the course of the past year, seven committees have formed to execute the plan.

“This collaborative effort has been progressing. We encourage others to get an update on the progress and find out how they can get involved, while enjoying food and fellowship,” said Pres. Hamilton.
