Transit options for Foxconn plant on agenda for Public Transportation Review Board

On **Wednesday** (March 28) the **Public Transportation Review Board** will discuss the possible expansion of transit connecting Milwaukee workers to the upcoming Foxconn facility in Racine County. The Board will review rail and bus opportunities including the proposed expanded Amtrak service line and the proposed expanded Milwaukee County bus line.

Representatives from Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission will join the board as it considers the costs, travel times and frequency of services to-and-from Foxconn, according to Board Chair **Alderman Robert J. Bauman**.
