### **Aldерwoman Coggs to host town hall covering city budget, landscape award winners, city services**

**Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs** invites residents to a town hall meeting **TOMORROW – Thursday, September 27th** that will include a discussion of Mayor Barrett’s 2019 proposed budget with City Budget Director **Dennis Yaccarino**, and the naming of the **6<sup>th</sup> District Landscape Award winners**. The meeting will take place starting at **5:30 p.m. Thursday in the gymnasium at the Siloah Lutheran School, 3730 N. 21st St.**

Alderwoman Coggs hopes that residents will take advantage of this opportunity to gain a better understanding of the budget and its potential impact on the 6<sup>th</sup> District. Representatives from the Department of Public Works, the Department of Neighborhood Services, the Neighborhood Improvement Development Corp., the Department of City Development and Milwaukee Police Department Districts 1 and 5 will all be present and available to answer questions.

“The city budget determines what the Council’s priorities will be as we set about making changes to the Mayor’s proposed \$1.53 billion spending plan,” Alderwoman Coggs said. “I welcome your ideas and comments on the budget, as input from our residents is critical as we go about shaping the future of our city.”
