## 2018 Bronzeville Week closing weekend

Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs is excited for the action packed, finale weekend of Bronzeville Week 2018. **Tonight (Thursday) August 9**, a Paint-N-Sip session will take place at 6 p.m. and another session at 8 p.m. at 4th Quarter Sports Bar & Grill, 2722 N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive.

**Friday, August 10** begins with the Mayor's Walk 100 Miles with Historic King Drive Business Improvement District and Alderwoman Coggs. The walk departs at 11 a.m. from Pete's Fruit Market, 2323 N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive. In the evening, a Young Professionals Trivia Night takes place at 6 p.m. at 4th Quarter Sports Bar & Grill, 2722 N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive. The Bronzeville Sleepover for Education takes place from 7 p.m. to 8 a.m. at N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive and North Ave. School supplies will be warmly accepted.

**Saturday, August 11** begins with Pancakes & Poetry at 9:30 a.m. at Rise & Grind Café, 2737 N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive. The Bronzeville Bike Ride will begin at 10 a.m. departing from 1950 N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive. The Bronzeville Black Food Truck Fest takes place from noon to 6 p.m. on Garfield Avenue (between N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive & 2nd St.). The Bronzeville Art Walk runs from noon to 6 p.m. on N. Dr. MLK Jr. Drive (various locations Hadley St. to McKinley Ave.)

“Whether you have been participating all week or have not yet made it to Bronzeville Week, this weekend is a great time to come down. The choice of events means there is something for everyone to enjoy,” Alderwoman Coggs said.

An official City of Milwaukee event now in its sixth full year, Bronzeville Week has blossomed as the premier celebration of Milwaukee’s rich African American legacy of culture, arts, history and entertainment.
