Municipal Court – Warrant Withdrawal Wednesday and employment resource event in the community

Individuals can register by calling **414-286-6600**, as there is no onsite registration. This event will take place on **Wednesday, August 22**, 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at **Journey House**, 2110 W. Scott St. Only cases registered will be heard, and registration is **limited to 250 people**. All registered participants will receive further detail on when to arrive at the event for check in. Those **NOT ELIGIBLE FOR WARRANT WITHDRAWAL** include people who have attended previous Warrant Withdrawal events **OR** have a Building and Zoning Code Case **OR** for those who only have a juvenile case. There is no registration fee to attend the employment and resource event. It is recommended that all participants bring employment materials to assist in the recruitment and application process.
