Community listening session to feature newly appointed head of Fire and Police Commission

Mayor Tom Barrett's choice to head the Fire and Police Commission – **La Keisha Butler** – will appear next Tuesday (**May 22**) at a community listening session on the near south side, **Alderman José G. Pérez** said today.

The public session will take place on Tuesday, May 22 at 5:30 p.m. at Gerald Ignace Indian Health Center, 930 W. Historic Mitchell St.

Ms. Butler became an Assistant City Attorney in 2014 and represented the Common Council's Licenses Committee, the Fire and Police Commission, and handled various types of litigation. She became the Director of Intergovernmental Relations in July 2017 and last month was appointed Executive Director of the Fire and Police Commission by Mayor Barrett.

"This is a prime opportunity for the community to meet Ms. Butler and ask questions about how she will approach her important role as executive director of the Fire and Police Commission. I urge citizens to attend this meeting on Tuesday," Alderman Pérez said.
