5th Annual Sock Drive event features music, basketball and fun

Alderman Russell W. Stamper, II will host the **5th Annual Sock Drive Basketball Tournament** tomorrow (**Saturday, February 3**) at the **Northside YMCA**, 1350 W. North Ave.

Alderman Stamper will be joined by representatives of the **Running Rebels**, who will be providing music, as well as a live podcast provided by **The Mogul Lounge**. **The event starts at 1 p.m. and admission is \$5 or a donation of brand new socks.**
