Work to affect public's access to Common Council – City Clerk's Office

Work to bring improvements to the reception area of the **Common Council – City Clerk's Office** (Room 205 at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.) will begin TOMORROW - Wednesday, July 31 and will impact access for members of the public, **City Clerk Jim Owczarski** said today.

Mr. Owczarski said the public will be directed to check in for all Common Council – City Clerk's Office business by entering the **License Division** (Room 105) while the remodeling work is being done.

“The work will help improve security as well as provide more space for our guests, and I credit the support of the Common Council for allowing us to pursue and push forward with this important project,” Mr. Owczarski said. “The work should be completed by the end of August and we ask visitors to please pardon our dust until the project is finished.”

It has been approximately 30 years since renovations or remodeling work has taken place in the main entrance and reception area of Room 205.
