### **A Complete Streets Project: South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street – West Lincoln to West Morgan Avenues**

**Alderman Mark A Borkowski** invites residents of the 11<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District and the general public to attend a **Public Involvement Meeting on Wednesday, July 10, 2019** concerning the potential pedestrian and traffic safety improvements along South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street from West Lincoln to West Morgan avenues.

The City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works is studying ways to improve conditions for people walking, biking, and driving along the S. 43<sup>rd</sup> St. corridor. Potential improvements may include reconfiguring the number of driving lanes, improving pedestrian crossings with high visibility crosswalks, new bike lanes, and added on-street parking. This involvement meeting will show several alternatives and gather feedback on the proposed improvements.

“This is an excellent opportunity for residents to offer input that will help shape the future of the South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street corridor and Jackson Park Neighborhood,” said Ald. Borkowski. “I invite the public to attend this meeting to learn more about this Complete Streets Project, and offer comments and suggestions to our DPW staff and to me.”
