### **City of Milwaukee “Don’t Litter” campaign with new stiffer fines begins April 1**

**WHAT:** With the snow finally melting, we see what’s been buried all winter along our streets, in parking lots and on our lawns – trash! Unfortunately, littering happens all year long, resulting in unsightly and unsanitary consequences in our neighborhoods. Alderman Russell W. Stamper sponsored legislation to increase the fine for all littering to \$500 (including all forfeitures, penalties, fees and assessments levied by the Municipal Court). The stiffer \$500 fine goes into effect on Monday, April 1 throughout the city.
