The meeting will take place on Thursday, September 24th from 5:30 – 8:00 p.m. at Nash Park.

It is easy to continue this cycle as the divisiveness is amplified and forget what we all have in common,” said Alderdwoman Dodd. “Therefore, I am calling on residents of the 5th District, The People’s Revolution, and community members to share their concerns about what is happening in our city so everyone gets access to public safety with ensured accountability. I also see this meeting as an opportunity to hear from the people as my colleagues and I prepare to deliberate on the Mayor’s 2021 budget and community priorities that will be released to the public next week Tuesday.”
