### Juneteenth Day community art event set for tomorrow – June 19th

**Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs** is inviting members of the community and media to attend a Juneteenth Day community street mural commission of Black Lives Matter tomorrow – June 19<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. The event will take place on King Drive at the intersection of N.
