## **Statement of Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs August 10, 2020**

Tomorrow – Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup> – is the fall partisan primary election here in Wisconsin, and the city has worked to make voting as safe and accessible as possible.

Nearly 170 polling places will be open for in-person voting tomorrow, and all sites will be equipped with enhanced safety measures to make sure those who do decide to vote in-person remain protected and socially distant. You can click [here](#) to find your polling place.

If you have not turned in your absentee ballot yet there is still time to do so. Absentee ballots can be turned in tomorrow between 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. at either the City Hall Election Commission Office, 200 E. Wells St, Room 501 or at the Election Commission Warehouse, 1901 S. Kinnickinnic Ave.
