Reward for information in Tay Jackson shooting increased to \$100k

Tuesday, August 25th marked the one year anniversary of the death of Quanita “Tay” Jackson, the young lady who was fatally shot near Moody Park. During a “Tay Day March” in honor of Tay, it was announced that the reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for the shooting was increased to \$100,000.

7th District Alderman **Alderman Khalif J. Rainey** is renewing the call for information related to this death. “One year after her death we remember Tay who was an exceptional young woman working to make a positive impact in her community. Her life was cut too short because of a senseless act of violence,” said Alderman Rainey. “I’m urging anyone with information that may lead to an arrest to step up and help bring to justice those responsible for Tay’s death.”
