Free COVID-19 testing available starting today

Statement of Alderwoman Chantia Lewis May 11, 2020

As of today (Monday, May 11) there are now two locations in Milwaukee that are offering free COVID-19 testing to anyone who wishes to be tested. These sites will operate daily from 8 a.m. – 8 p.m. with assistance from the National Guard and no appointment is necessary. Those tested can expect to have results back within 72 hours.

The locations are:

- UMOs headquarters, 2701 S. Chase Ave.
- Midtown Center, 5760 W. Capitol Dr.

I encourage anyone who is experiencing symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell), works directly with the public, or lives in an area with a high concentration of positive cases to take advantage of this opportunity.

Please remember if you are experiencing symptoms do not take public transportation to a testing site. Call 2-1-1 to be connected to a community health center that can assist in providing transportation.
