Wilson Park Gazebo refurbishment complete; ceremony set for Saturday

A gazebo restored as part of an Eagle Scout project will be unveiled during a special public ceremony tomorrow – Saturday, October 24th in Wilson Park.

After 13 months, the Wilson Park Gazebo (1601 W. Howard Ave.) has been fully refurbished. Zeno Wilson planned the refurbishing work on the formerly dilapidated gazebo as his Eagle Scout Project for Troop 208, said **Alderman Scott Spiker**, whose 13th Aldermanic District includes the gazebo site.

On Saturday, Alderman Spiker will be joined by Milwaukee County **Supervisor Jason Haas**, friends, fellow Scouts, family, and community members to recognize Zeno's work to renovate the Wilson Park Gazebo. **Media coverage is invited.**

The ceremony will be outdoors but masks will be required, as well as appropriate physical distancing.

“Zeno displayed outstanding leadership and project management skills, hard work, dedication, and a teamwork-focused drive to restore this beloved community landmark to a heightened state of beautification,” Alderman Spiker said.

Zeno Wilson recruited fellow troop members, classmates, and community members to help with the restoration. He received support from Custom Grown Greenhouse, Home Depot, Bliffert Lumber, The Garden District, local residents, supporters and friends. In total, 345 hours were spent on this project with 28 volunteers – with Zeno alone working 125 of those hours.
