Virtual 14th District town hall meeting set for Wednesday, September 9

14th District Alderwoman Marina Dimitrijevic will host a virtual town hall meeting on **Wednesday, September 9th from 6 – 7 p.m.** to discuss relevant issues with residents. The virtual town hall will cover a variety of topics including 2021 budget priorities, public safety, public works projects and more. The meeting will also include discussion of the results of the District 14 100 day survey that has been circulated in recent weeks to gather input on city issues and services during the Alderwoman’s first 100 days in office.
