COVID-19 Vaccine Virtual Town Hall taking place Feb. 10

Common Council President Cavalier Johnson and **Public Safety and Health Committee Chair Alderwoman Marina Dimitrijevic** are encouraging residents to attend the COVID-19 Vaccine Virtual Town Hall set for **Wednesday, February 10 at 6 p.m.**

“This virtual event is the ideal setting for residents to hear directly from local health professionals who will separate vaccine fact from fiction, and share the most up-to-date info on vaccine safety, the distribution processes and overall timeline,” said President Johnson.

The town hall, hosted by the Milwaukee Health Department, will be moderated by Tony Atkin, Reporter at TMJ4. Panelists include: Milwaukee Mayor Tom Barrett; Marlaina Jackson, MPA - Interim Commissioner of City of MKE Health Department; Julia Means, RN at Ascension Health - St. Mary’s & City of MKE Board of Health Member; and Heather Paradis, MD, MPH, Deputy Commissioner of Medical Services & Chief Medical Officer, City of Milwaukee Health Department.
